UPDATE: POISON OAK ROAD EXPANSION

The City of Temple has released more information regarding the Poison Oak Road expansion which is estimated to begin during the Fall of 2019. All properties close to Poison Oak Road on the south side will be purchased by the City for the widening of the road. There will be a middle divide with green space to help flow traffic through the safest method into our neighborhood. This will mean that Carriage House Drive will be closed to eastbound traffic. The only entry for eastbound traffic into our neighborhood will be through Ridgeway Drive. Westbound traffic will have access to both entries off of Poison Oak. We are asking that trees be planted in the area between our neighborhood fence and the new sidewalk to assist with noise reduction. HOMEOWNER TIP:

Please report any suspicious activity to the local police.

We had multiple houses report break-ins to vehicles on Carriage House Drive on September 13th at 9:45pm. The perpetrator was video taped while in one of the cars and the video was submitted to the police. It appears to be a young white male. Exterior Lights – Good exterior lighting improves safety and provides property ambiance. It is important to consider any dark, unlit areas and balance that with the effect of bright lights streaming into your neighbors' bedroom windows. There are light bulbs and light bulb attachments that allow for dusk till dawn lighting without any extra wiring needed that can be used on porch and garage lighting to make an inexpensive upgrade. If you're a little handier, sensors can be installed into the light fixture for approximately \$10. Solar pathway lights are another simple way to add lighting to your property.
